Dear Parents/Carers,

Many thanks to the teachers, support staff and volunteers who give up their own time to run these clubs. Please remember if your child is unable to attend on a particular day, then **you** must inform the school office admin@topsham.devon.sch.uk or for privately run clubs, please inform the provider directly, so that we can account for the children.

Spaces in clubs will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. In order to enroll for a club, **please book a place via SchoolComms** using the payments option (*not the clubs option*). **The option to book places online via Schoolcomms will go live on Saturday 2nd October.** If the club has availability, you will be able to book and pay online. Please ensure that you notify us of the collection arrangements for your child by adding this to the comments box.

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please book and pay online. The cost of the club will then be refunded at the end of term as long as your child has attended the club on a regular basis.

In the event of a club having to be cancelled, we will contact parents via text alert, so please ensure that you have registered for SchoolComms and we have up-to-date contact details for you. Please be aware that, due to a range of circumstances and commitments, clubs can and will be cancelled at times. Please ensure you have provision for the collection of your child at the end of the school day in the event of cancellation of a club.

In the event of a private club having to be cancelled, parents will be contacted directly by SportsyStars, Premier Sports or Exeter City.

Dates and times for clubs:

All after school clubs will take place from 3.30-4.30pm.

All lunchtime clubs will take place within the Key Stage's lunchtime. Consideration will be given to ensuring all children have time to eat lunch.
