Times Tables Rock Star: KS2



Next Friday, KS2 will take part in NSPCC ROCKS, way of celebrating the work that the NSPCC does to support children and their families, and celebrate Number Day.

They will take part in an online times tables competition that will boost maths confidence alongside accuracy and recall speed.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Learners will answer as many multiplication and division questions correctly as they can. The winning school and class will be based on the highest average number of correct answers per pupil.

RULES:

- 1. Every correct answer that a student gives, in any game type, between the hours of 7:30am GMT and 19:30pm GMT on Friday 2 February will contribute to their class and school score.
- 2. There is a 60-minute limit playtime per player.
- 3. Children will have time in class across the day to take part, but they can play before and after school as well.

Our KS2 children already work super hard on their tables, they play against each other and between classes. This will now allow their points to be part of a nationwide competition!
