Dear Parents,

We are writing to tell you about an exciting change that will be taking place at The Topsham School. We have decided to replace the current School Council with a new initiative called Class Ambassadors.

Under this new system, one student from each class will be selected as a Class Ambassador for each whole term. The Class Ambassador will represent their class in various capacities and will work closely with the year 6 School Leaders. They will meet twice a half term to discuss and address important school matters.

The responsibilities of the class ambassador will be as follows:

1. Acting as the class representative for any new visitors or children joining our school. The class ambassador will warmly welcome them and assist them with their transition into our school community.
2. Supporting the year 6 school leaders in collecting pupil voice. This means that they will seek feedback from their classmates on various school-related matters, such as suggestions for improvement or sharing their experiences and concerns.
3. Speaking confidently to visitors about their class and the fantastic learning that is taking place. The Class Ambassador will be the voice of their class, representing their achievements and conveying their experiences.
4. Assisting in the organisation of charity events. The class ambassador will take an active role in supporting the planning and coordination of fundraising activities.

The selection process for Class Ambassadors will involve a vote by their classmates, ensuring that every child has a say in who represents them. The vote will take place during a class meeting on Wednesday 4th October. The children who would like to put themselves forward do not need to prepare anything, but will need to be ready to talk to their class about why they would be a good Class Ambassador.
