### Applying for a Reception (Big Acorns) place for September 2024

Children born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020 will start primary school in September 2024. Devon County Council's application process is now open for the Reception September 2024 intake and it will remain open until 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024. 




#### SAFEGUARDING
