Attendance Information

Every School Day Counts! In order for our pupils to achieve their very best it is of paramount importance that their attendance is good. Every lesson really does count for your child and catching up on lost time from school can be really difficult.

Good attendance is linked to achievement, better relationships with other children and overall better behaviour. Often, the reason that children are absent from school is due to illness and it is important that you contact the school on every day of your child's absence due to ill health. Please contact the school office and leave a message before 8.30am so that our registers can be updated. We understand that sometimes absence cannot be avoided.

Punctuality – It is SO important that the children arrive to school on time, ready and willing to learn. The gates open at 8.45am. Any child who arrives after the gates are locked at 8.55am needs to be signed in at the main school reception. Being late for school reduces learning time and can impact on your child being able to settle calmly into the school day. Children can be upset at entering a busy classroom after everyone

Attendance Ladder




else and missing the initial morning instructions means that they are having to play 'catch-up' for the rest of the morning. If your child is 5 minutes late every day, they will miss approximately 3 days of learning in a year. 15 minutes late every day, equates to approximately 2 weeks of missed learning each year.


Safeguarding is EVERYONE'S business and we will always do our very best to keep our children safe.
